The meeting was called to order at 6:19pm.

**Acceptance of Minutes:**

The following correspondence was reviewed:

- Letter from Chuck Braxton re: properties owned by Christopher Boulger. The letter informed the Selectmen that the properties owned by Mr. Boulger were involuntarily merged by the Town on or before 2007. Mr. Boulger is requesting the Board to revert the properties to their original lots. The Administrative Assistant informed the Board that the assessor is aware of this request and recommends that the Board approve the request. After a brief discussion, Jennie motioned to have the assessor revert the properties, owned by Christopher Boulger, to their original state. Leon second. Motion passed.
